
- Attention!

We are sharing the park with two other groups. We will be on the Cross-country side of Montrose Rd. There will be an event on the Derby Field (where we usually have dressage and cones) and another on the Barn/Show Arenas side of Montrose Rd. **DO NOT DRIVE YOUR CARRIGES** on the Derby Field or the barn/show arena side of the street.

-Carriage Drivers will enter the Park from N. Horace Mann RD through Gate 9. This is at the far end of the old Steeplechase track close to where they store the cross country jumps.

- We will have a registration desk set up near the parking area for you to show your Coggins and vaccination record, sign releases and pay your fees and get your carriage pass showing you as either Obstacle Schooling or Social Drive of both. Social Drive \$25, Obstacle Schooling \$25, or both for \$45.

- We will have a Safety Check for all turnouts and then you can proceed at will to the obstacles or the track for the social drive.



-We will have some drinks and snacks and there will be food vendors available by the horse show across the street.

-there will be water and hoses available by the parking area.

- Dogs must be leashed.

Information for Obstacle Schooling:

- There will be three obstacles marked and open for schooling from 10 am till 2 pm.
- Drivers must have a navigator on the carriage or a ground person in close attendance.
- Drivers and navigators must have helmets and back protectors.
- Juniors must have a knowledgeable adult on the carriage.
- Turnouts must go through the safety check before proceeding to the obstacles.

Information for the Social Drive:

- We will have a marked route winding around the cross country/marathon course with shorter and longer options.

- Everyone riding on a carriage must sign a release.
- Juniors must have a knowledgeable adult on the carriage.
- Juniors must wear a helmet whenever on a carriage.
- Everyone is encouraged to have a groom/passenger on the carriage.
- Pairs must have a groom/passenger, and fours must have two grooms/passengers.
- Turnouts must go through the safety check before proceeding to the marked drive
